Join us on a visit to Windsor Castle  
(the oldest and largest occupied castle in the world)  
  
and The Savill Garden  
(including a rose garden opened by the Queen in 2010)



**Windsor Castle:** We will arrive in time to buy refreshments (NOT included) or have a walk around, before timed entrance to the castle at 10.00 am for a self-guided tour that includes the State Apartments where the Queen hosts official visits, the Grand Reception room and Queen Mary's Doll's house. There is also St George's Chapel, construction of which started back in 1475, that has hosted many Royal weddings and is home to the Order of the Garter. There are views of the Round Tower and Quadrangle. This year we can also see the Coronation dress and robe worn by the Queen and designed by Sir Norman Hartnell. There is a small cafe if you need to stop and catch your breath after all the splendour.

**The Savill Garden:** We return to the coach to travel on to The Savill Garden, commissioned in 1932 by George V and designed by Sir Eric Savill. We will arrive in time for lunch which is NOT included, but there is a cafe, a restaurant or you may wish to take your own food. We have free time to explore the extensive gardens, beautiful herbaceous borders and the eye-catching Savill Building.

Our coach will leave from Upper High Street car park Epsom at 8.00am and we aim to return there about 6pm.

**Tickets:** The cost will be **£44** per person, which includes coach travel, driver's gratuity, and entrance fees.

Tickets will be on sale from **09.30 am** prior to our lecture on **Wednesday 4 May**. We will only accept payment by credit/debit card and tickets will be limited to two per member (both TASE members). We will not be selling online. In the event of your cancellation, refunds will only be made if places are later resold.
